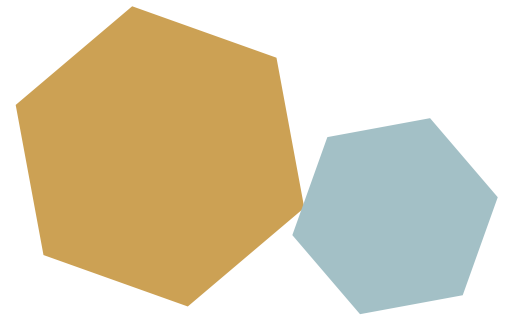

INETTT at a glance

- Independent, strategic, non-profit, global network working to scale and speed up sustainable energy transitions.
- A trusted platform for stakeholder exchange and robust data-based policy analysis and recommendations.
- Launched in 2018, coordinated and hosted by Agora Energiewende in Berlin; Terms of Reference adopted in 2020.
- Cooperation network of currently 18 think tanks in 15 countries and 1 regional network (SE3T.Net) on research, exchange and capacity building.
- Governance Structure and Strategic Framework finalized in 2024.

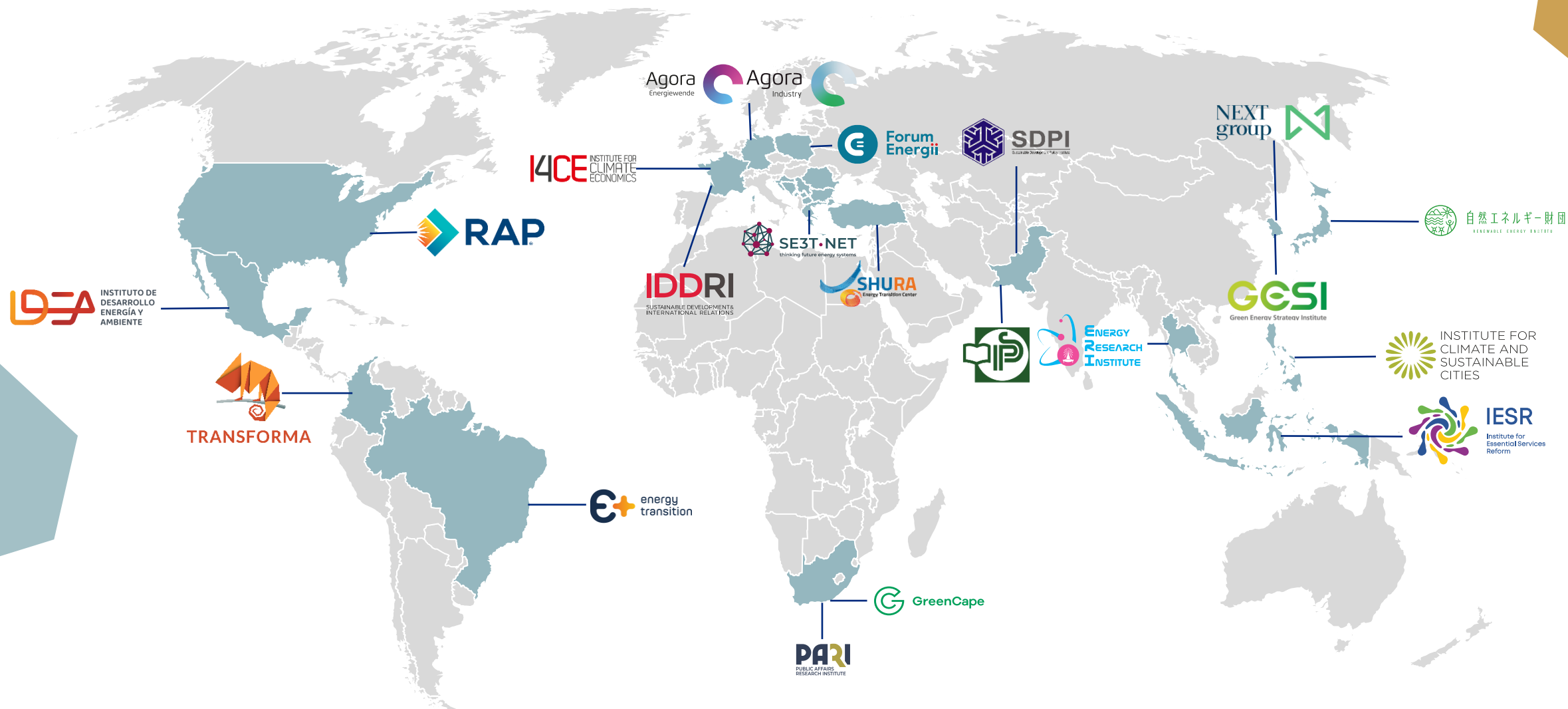
Mission and vision

by engaging with policymakers, civil society and other stakeholders, highlighting the need for diverse perspectives on global challenges.

Facilitating access to financial support

for dedicated project work for member think tanks and energy transition research, thereby helping build sustainable bottom-up capacity in developing countries for credible transition-related studies.



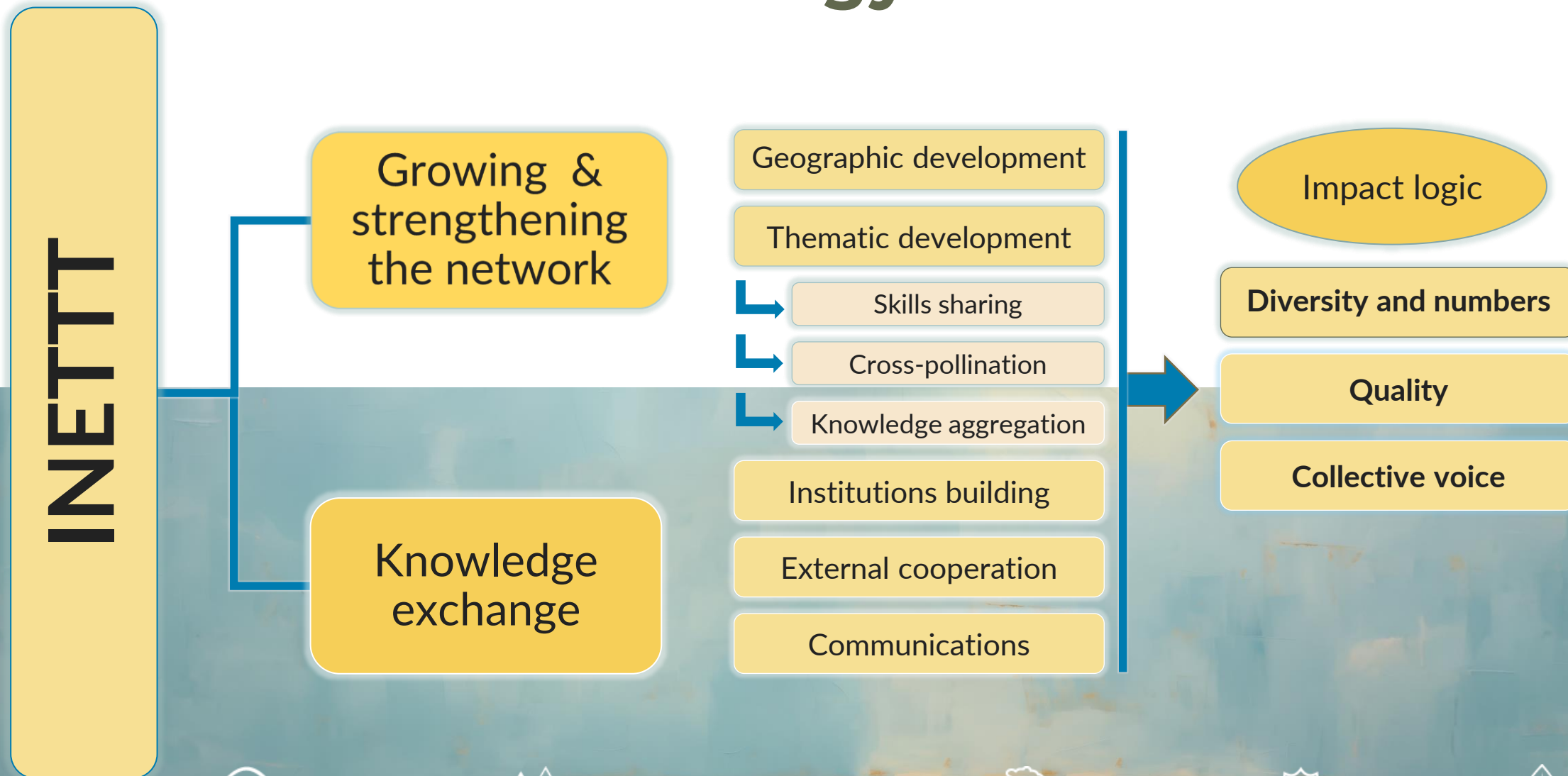
